RMFT-119 Certificate of Exemption for the Sale of Gasoline or Diesel Fuel for Use as Fuel in Aircraft

Read this information first: You may be exempt from the Motor Fuel Tax when you sell gasoline or clear diesel for aviation purposes if you obtain this exemption certificate identifying who used the fuel for aviation purposes. The customer must sign stating that they are using the fuel for aviation purposes. If you sell gasoline or clear diesel fuel for aviation purposes, you must collect the UST/EIF on the gallons. Scan and attach this certificate to your electronically filed Form RMFT-5, Motor Fuel Distributor/Supplier Tax Return. Retain the original certificate in your records for inspection, if necessary.
