



Illinois Department of Revenue IL-2000, Request for Verification of IDOR-approved Credit for Illinois Withholding Income Tax

Important Information

- Use this form **only** if the information you provided on your original Form IL-941, Illinois Withholding Income Tax Return is correct and you overpaid the tax due for that period. If you need to correct your Form IL-941, you must file a Form IL-941-X, Amended Illinois Income Tax Withholding Return. See the instructions for the Form IL-941, Form IL-941-X, and Publication 131.
- You cannot use an overpayment until it has been approved by us, in writing, as an IDOR-approved credit.
- Do not use this form to move payments, to request a refund, or to request any other transaction besides the verification of your IDOR-approved credit. This request will not be processed if it is attached to your IL-941, IL-941-X, or any notice sent by us.

Step 1: Business information

Enter your name, Federal employer identification number (FEIN), period, and year for which you are requesting to have your credit verified.

 - the date range covered by the records, and
 - name, SSN, income amount, and Illinois tax withheld for each payee.
