Four Establishments Cited for Selling to Minors

WAUKEGAN – Four establishments in Waukegan were cited Thursday for liquor license violations after they allegedly sold alcohol to minors as part of an undercover operation conducted by Illinois Liquor Control Commission (ILCC) agents, Illinois State Police, and the Waukegan Police Department.

As part of Thursday’s operation, four of 23 establishments checked sold alcohol to underage minors, including:

Jacobs	1005 Golf	Waukegan
Jozino's	3457 Sunset	Waukegan
Glen Rock Beverages	834 Glen Rock	Waukegan
Waukegan Citgo	2400 Grand	Waukegan

All were cited by agents and each will be referred to the Illinois Liquor Control Commission for action. The penalties for selling alcohol to minors can include fines and/or liquor license suspension or revocation.

“Under-age drinking is a serious problem in Illinois,” said Lainie Krozel, Executive Director of the ILCC. “Our licensees must check identification before they make a sale. Those who do not will face consequences.”

The undercover operations are part of ongoing statewide checks made throughout the year to assure compliance with the law that prohibits the sale of alcohol to minors.
