Liquor Control Commission February Underage Compliance Report

SPRINGFIELD – In February 2016, the Illinois Liquor Control Commission (ILCC) conducted compliance checks around the state and visited 57 businesses licensed to sell liquor. They cited 7 for violations of liquor control laws. Eighty-eight percent of the licensees visited complied with Illinois liquor laws and refused to serve underage customers.

This is a monthly aggregated report of all the underage compliance investigations conducted in the month of February. The ILCC may release results on individual investigations through shorter press releases throughout the month.

The monthly aggregated report lists all of the results of ongoing undercover and cooperative law enforcement operations conducted by Illinois Liquor Control Commission (ILCC) agents, local law enforcement officials and volunteers from high schools and colleges. The teams randomly visit liquor stores, restaurants and bars in communities around the state to check for ongoing compliance with state laws mandating that no liquor is sold to minors under the age of 21. ILCC agents also work with local and state law enforcement agents to focus on communities with a high incidence of underage liquor sales.

Below is the bulleted list by location of which establishments violated the law by selling alcohol to ILCC underage participants. Because the visits are random in nature, certain areas of the State are visited at certain times of the year.

DOLTON– February 17th, the ILCC and the Dolton Police Department conducted underage alcohol checks in Dolton. Of the 14 licensees checked, six sold alcohol to ILCC underage participants. Those licensees were:

LEMONT– February 16th, the ILCC and the Lemont Police Department conducted underage alcohol checks in Lemont. Of the 15 licensees checked, zero sold alcohol to ILCC underage participants.

LINCOLNWOOD – February 11th, the ILCC and the Lincolnwood Police Department conducted underage alcohol checks in Lincolnwood. Of the 13 licensees checked, zero sold alcohol to ILCC underage participants.

SANGAMON COUNTY– February 19th, the ILCC and the Illinois State Police conducted underage alcohol checks in Sangamon County. Of the 15 licensees checked, one sold alcohol to ILCC underage participants. That licensee was:
