Liquor Control Commission April Underage Compliance Report

SPRINGFIELD – In **April** the Illinois Liquor Control Commission (ILCC) conducted compliance checks around the state and visited 242 businesses licensed to sell liquor. They cited 42 licensees for violations of liquor control laws. Eighty-three percent of the licensees visited complied with Illinois liquor laws and refused to serve underage customers.

This report is a result of ongoing undercover and cooperative law enforcement operations conducted by Illinois Liquor Control Commission (ILCC) agents and local law enforcement officials and volunteers from high schools and colleges. The teams randomly visit liquor stores, restaurants and bars in communities around the state to check for ongoing compliance with state laws mandating that no liquor is sold to minors under the age of 21. ILCC agents also work with local and state law enforcement agents to focus on communities with a high incidence of underage liquor sales.

Bloomington/Normal – April 30, the ILCC and the Illinois Secretary of Police conducted underage compliance checks in the Bloomington-Normal area. Of the 34 licensees checked no licensee sold alcohol to ILCC underage participants.

Cass County -- April 11, the ILCC and the Illinois Secretary of State Police conduct underage compliance checks. Of the 13 licensees checked, four sold alcohol to ILCC underage participants. Those licensees were:
