TO: Licensed Interstate Motor Carriers  
SUBJECT: Commercial Motor Vehicle Definition

The definition of a commercial motor vehicle has been changed effective July 1, 1986 by Public Act 84-1076. The word "combination" has been deleted from the previous definition. By deleting the word "combination", any power unit (truck, road tractor, or truck tractor) with less than three axles, will not be required to display a decal .

If this definition change means that your firm has ordered more decals than needed, you may return any unneeded decals to the Department of Revenue and request a refund. This request for refund must state that the request is because of Informational Bulletin FY87-14.
