

+ INCREASE IN THE TAX ON COIN-OPERATED AMUSEMENT DEVICES

Illinois has raised the tax on coin-operated amusement devices. For January 1 through January 31, 1990, the rate will be \$25. Thereafter, the rate will be \$15 per year and \$8 per half-year. In addition, beginning in 1990, you will pay either a full-year or a half-year rate, depending on when you place your machine in service. The license year, August 1 through July 31, will remain the same.

WHAT ARE THE NEW RATES?

If you will not be adding any new machines between January 1 and July 31, 1990, you will simply pay \$15 per decal when your present decals expire on July 31, 1990. We will send you applications for renewing your decals before they expire.

If you add new machines between January 1 and July 31, 1990, here is what you will pay:

- \$25 for decals purchased in January
- \$8 for decals purchased between February 1 and July 31

Thereafter, you will pay \$15 for decals purchased between August 1 and the following January 31, and \$8 for decals purchased between February 1 and July 31.
