CHANGES IN MOTOR FUEL
USE TAX RATE

Effective July 1, 1990,
the "Part B" rate
increased .4> per
gallon. The new rate is
4.5> per gallon. This
is equal to 5 percent
of the average selling
price of special fuel
used in Illinois.

The "average selling
price per gallon of
special fuel" is an
official figure
computer and adjusted
annually by the
Department of Revenue.
The Department used
this figure to
calculate a cents-per-
gallon rate - or "Part
B rate" - which is
equivalent to 5 percent
of the official price.

The part "A" motor fuel
tax rate for diesel
fuel remains at 21.5>
per gallon.

The new combined rate
is 26> per gallon for
lines 6 and 7b on Form
IDR-280.

FILING YOUR RETURNS
(FORM IDR-280)

Beginning with the third
quarter of 1990, you
will receive revised
forms indicating the new
combined Motor Fuel Use
Tax rate.
