Illinois Department of Revenue IL-941-X Amended Illinois Withholding Tax Return

Read this information first.

Complete Form IL-941-X only to correct an error you made on a previously filed Form IL-941 or IL-941-A (if an annual filer last year) in reporting

- Line 1, amounts subject to withholding, or
- Line 2, total Illinois Income Tax actually withheld (including any excess amount withheld) **OR** in prior years stated as "Illinois Income Tax required to be withheld."

What if I withheld the wrong amount of tax from an employee?

Do not file IL-941-X if you reported the amount you actually withheld, even if you withheld the wrong amount. If you discover an error in withholding before the end of the year, you should correct the error by adjusting the amount you withhold from the employee's wages during the remainder of the year.

If you cannot correct the error before the end of the year, you must make sure that your withholding tax return and the employee's Form W-2 report the actual amount withheld. If you withheld too much, the employee will receive a refund on his or her income tax return and if you withheld too little, the employee will receive a smaller refund or owe tax on his or her income tax return.

If you made the same reporting error on your return and your employee's Form W-2, you must also provide your employee with a corrected Form W-2-C and attach copies of the W-2-C forms to your IL-941-X.

Step 1: Complete the following account information

When is Form IL-941-X due?

Report increases in your tax due immediately to minimize penalties and interest. If your change decreases your tax due, file IL-941-X no later than

- three years after the 15th day of the 4th month following the close of the calendar year in which the tax was withheld, or
- one year after the date the tax was paid.

You may be assessed penalties and interest if your IL-941-X is filed after the due date of your original return. If so, we will send you a notice.

Which steps must I complete?

You must complete Steps 1, 2, and 3 to report changes previously reported on your IL-941 or IL-941-A (if an annual filer last year). If we agree that you have a valid overpayment, it will first be applied to any outstanding liabilities and then applied as you request on Line 3 of future IL-941s.
