GIVING CREDIT WHERE IT'S DUE

VOLUNTEER FIREFIGHTER TAX CREDIT

If you have served for at least nine months as a part-time volunteer emergency worker for a fire department or fire protection district, or are a fire protection association member and have not received compensation for those services of more than \$5,000 during the taxable year, you may be eligible for Illinois' new Volunteer Emergency Worker Tax Credit. This tax credit can reduce the amount of Illinois individual income tax you owe by up to \$500.

Be one of the first 10,000 qualified candidates to apply with the Illinois Department of Revenue starting February 3, 2025.
