
Sales Tax Jurisdiction Boundary Verification Map

This map is in accordance to the Leveling the Playing Field for Illinois Retail Act, 35 ILCS 185/5-1 et seq. Beginning February 1, 2022, and on or before February 1 of each year thereafter, the Department shall make available to each local taxing jurisdiction the taxing jurisdiction's boundaries, determined by the Department, for its verifications. Jurisdictions shall verify these taxing jurisdiction boundaries and notify the Department of any changes, additions or deletions by April 1 of each year in the form and manner required by the Department. The Department shall use its best judgment and information to confirm the information provided by the taxing jurisdictions and update its database. The Department shall administer and enforce such changes on the first day of the next following July.

Default Extent


- **Panning** – use the mouse by holding down the left mouse button and move the mouse in the desired direction.

- **Changing Scale** – roll the mouse wheel forward or backward to zoom in and out. The controls located on the left side of the map also allow you to zoom in and out.

- **Full View** – clicking on the Default Extent button located on the left side of the map will return the map to the default full extent view.








